

## Guidelines for Application on the “Hamaguchi Award”

### QUALIFICATION

The award is given to individuals and /or organizations that have made significant contributions to the enhancement of coastal resilience against tsunami, storm surge and other coastal disasters.

- Researcher (scientific contributions)
- Practitioner (pragmatic contributions)

### SELECTION RANGE

Achievement until the end of 2021 will be evaluated.

### CANDIDACY CRITERIA

The candidates eligible for the Hamaguchi Award are those persons or organizations nominated by qualified nominators as follows:

- Ministries and government offices, U.N. agency, or Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) of each country
- Other researchers (for researcher nominee only)

One nominator can recommend one nominee only.

The nominator must submit the nomination form and if necessary reference materials.

### SELECTION

The Selection Committee on the Hamaguchi Award will select the recipients.

### AWARD CEREMONY

The award ceremony and commemorative lectures by recipients will be held in Tokyo, Japan, in late October or early November.

### DEADLINE

The entry must be received no later than May 31, 2022.
